



## White House Aging Report Includes Gays

The "Final Report of the 2005 White House Conference on Aging" is just out and for the first time includes explicit mention of LGBT issues. One resolution calls for the expansion of "the definition of minority populations to include gays, lesbians, bisexuals, and transgenders and seniors with disabilities." The **National Gay and Lesbian Task Force** and Services and Advocacy for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, and Transgender Elders, or SAGE, were part of a "Make Room for All" summit in December that challenged the White House conference to be more inclusive of the nation's diverse older people. They are working with other groups in the Diversity in Aging Coalition to continue this advocacy.
