



Dannielynn's Guardian labeled 'Top Lawyer'

Richard C. Milstein, a Miami-Dade attorney, was appointed by Broward Circuit Court Judge Larry Seidlin to represent Dannielynn.

Milstein, 60, has been in practice for over 30 years, specializing in trusts, estates and guardianship litigation. He was admitted to the bar in 1974 and has received numerous awards, including being listed as a Top Lawyer in Family Law by the South Florida Legal Guide, 2006.

At 41, Milstein realized he was gay, he told The Miami Herald in November 2005. After 19 years of marriage, he got divorced. The couple had two children.

The Miami Herald interviewed Milstein, then 59, after he was honored with the 2005 Humanitarian Award by the **National Gay and Lesbian Task Force** for his years of philanthropic service. Over the years, Milstein helped facilitate and personally raise a combined total of over a quarter-million dollars for the annual AIDS Walk.

Milstein told The Miami Herald that he has remained friends with his ex-wife and stays close with his children.
