



Fact sheet: Homeless lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) youth in New York

1) How many homeless youth are there in the city of New York?

- a) Between 15,000 and 20,000 homeless youth in the city of New York according to local estimates. A city-funded count is pending in spring 2007.

2) How many are LGBT?

- a) Approximately 3,000 to 8,000 homeless youth in New York City are LGBT.
- b) This calculation is based on research that demonstrates that 20 to 40 percent of all homeless youth identify LGBT.

3) What are the public agencies that deal with homeless youth?

- a) New York City Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) administers requests for proposals and distributes funds for homeless youth programming on behalf of the city and state.

4) What has the city done to address needs of homeless LGBT youth?

- a) The City of New York allocated \$1.2 million in FY 2006 for three service providers that specifically reach out to LGBT homeless youth: \$400,000 each to Sylvia's Place, Green Chimneys and Ali Forney Center (see contact info for these agencies below).
- b) A further \$2.6 million is allocated for FY 2007 (above the baselined \$5 million) and includes LGBT-specific funds and other programs.
 - a) Green Chimneys has received approximately \$425,000 of these funds and Ali Forney is getting somewhere between \$260,000 and \$400,000.
- c) The New York City Council also allocated \$50,000 to fund a count of homeless youth in spring 2007.
